A Rhode Island landmark has debuted its new face. Watch Hill Inn in Watch Hill, Rhode Island, an 18-room building originally built in 1845 and listed on the National Historical Landmark Register in Washington, D.C, has undergone a complete renovation to become an all-suite, luxury property. Designer Donna Simmons (working for operator Ocean House Management's Ocean House Design Group) has created an updated interpretation of effortless East Coast style.
