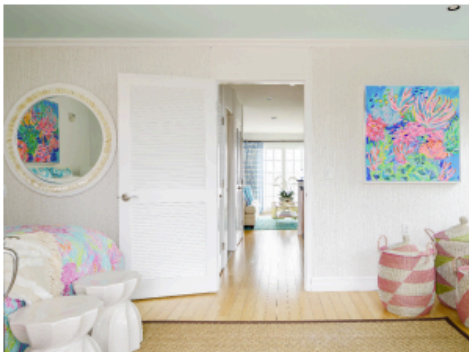




Head to the Ocean House this Summer
